



## **MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION**

**between**

**Management Development Institute of Singapore in Tashkent**

**and**

**Singapore International School**

### **1. Participants of the Memorandum**

**Management Development Institute of Singapore in Tashkent** (hereinafter referred to as MDIST), represented by Rector Dr. I.A.Mamatkulov, acting on the basis of the Charter, on the one hand, and **Singapore International School** (hereinafter referred to as SIS), represented by Director Dr. T.A.Khasanov, acting on the basis of Charter, hereinafter referred to as the Parties, have concluded this Memorandum on the following:

### **2. Subject of the Memorandum**

2.1 The purpose of this Memorandum is the intention of the Parties to cooperate and develop teaching methods and experience exchange;

2.2 For the purpose of mutual cooperation, the Parties intend to implement joint projects in the field of teaching and learning processes.

2.3 The Parties intend to cooperate in order to provide mutual support and favorable conditions for the education of MDIST students and improve the quality of teaching at the SIS.

### **3. Obligations of the Parties**

3.1 The obligations of the Parties include:

- Providing all possible assistance in establishing cooperation in areas of mutual interest;
- Organizing joint symposia, seminars, conferences, round tables, and other initiatives in the field of the key areas of activity of the Parties;
- Implementation of joint projects and programs;



## **5. Term and Termination of the Memorandum**

5.1 This Memorandum shall enter into force upon its signing by the Parties for a period of 10 (ten) years and shall be valid until its termination;

5.2 The Memorandum may be terminated early at the initiative of any of the Parties. The Party intending to terminate the Memorandum shall notify the other Parties in writing no later than 15 working days before the date of the intended termination of the Memorandum;

5.3 If none of the Parties has expressed an intention to terminate the Memorandum upon the expiration of its validity period, the Memorandum shall be automatically extended for the next year.

## **6. Final Provisions**

6.1 This Memorandum is drawn up and signed in two copies in English, having equal legal force, one copy for each Party;


6.2 All changes and additions to this Memorandum shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties;


